Peter is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, an international arbitration service in London.

**Douglas H, Wigdor** is a founding partner of Thompson Wigdor & Gilly LLP. In this interview, he gives a compelling overview to his representation of a group of women in a gender discrimination class action against Citigroup.
